Biblical Justice

Read: Psalm 82

Ask:

- How do you define justice?
- Do you think God demands all people to do biblical justice whether they are Christian or not?
- How does this impact how you view Christian faith in the public square? Should Christians voice their beliefs in the public square? Why or why not?
- How does God's special concern for the vulnerable and downtrodden square with the issue of abortion in our country?
- Why does justice require truth?
- How does the promise of God's judgment of all people and every nation affect how you evangelize and proclaim the need for justice?
- What can you do to strive for justice in your own life? Family? Our church? Our community? Our nation?
- Is there any sin in your own life that you need to confess and repent of?

Pray:

- Thank God for being the one who sees the plight of the vulnerable and oppressed.
- Praise God for being the God of justice and righteousness who always does right and is always true
- Confess that we are sinful people in need of grace, and we live in the midst of a sinful people who love evil and injustice
- Ask for God to give us boldness in proclaiming the command of God to do justice and the gospel of grace in Christ
